



Early Porn Exposure

• Average age of first exposure = 9-12, many as early as 6 years of age

• For Profit: diet pills, drugs, beauty aids

The Numbers Are Growing

The Girls' Attitudes Survey (UK, February 2025) found:

77% of girls aged 7-21 have experienced an online harm

The new research reveals that the online harms and misogynistic content girls are experiencing online makes them feel unsafe (34%) and unable to tell a parent or carer (32%).








Social Media / Social Algorithms – What's Happening

Prioritizes Engagement Over Well-being

Push unsolicited distressing material to minors, triggering doomscrolling, which leads to anxiety & depression

Amplifies negative and sensational content

Promotes "highlight reels" creating FOMO

= MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES

Exploits Vulnerabilities of Youth

Unrealistic comparisons encourages "me too" behavior

Normalizes harmful ideologies (misogyny/violence in "intimacy", extreme challenges)

DMs expose at-risk youth to online predators







Social Media Promotes Hypersexualized Content





Youth Are Worried About Deep Fakes

1 in 4 youth have seen a deepfake

In March this year, Thorn released findings from a survey of 1,200 teens ages 13-20. The key findings indicate that:

- 84% of teens believe deepfake nudes are harmful, citing emotional distress (30%), reputational damage (29%), and deception (26%) as top reasons.
- Deepfake nudes already represent real experiences that our young people have to navigate.
- The young people who admit to creating deepfake nudes of others describe having **easy access** to deepfake technologies.

Virtual Worlds - Real Dangers





Former Meta researchers Cayce Savage and Dr. Jason Sattizahn testified before the Senate Judiciary Committee in September, 2025 that Meta buried and manipulated research showing its VR platforms were harming children, including those as young as 10.

What Do Children Experience in Virtual Reality Systems?

- Over 44% NEARLY HALF OF YOUTH received hate speech or slur
- One in three youth (37.6%) experienced bullying
- One in three (35%) were harassed
- One in five (19%) were sexually harassed, and
- One in five (18.1%) faced grooming or predatory behavior.

* Girls were more likely than boys to experience sexual harassment and grooming.



Helping Parents

Ineffective Reactions: Detachment or Over-Controlling

Ask questions and then Listen!!

Be their safe place to share anything
Include them in digital safety planning
Get to know their friends

Pray for & with them often
Talk about their identity in Christ
Value them highly
Study God's word together
Demonstrate authenticity,
compassion & forgiveness

Spiritual

Physical

Digital Protections at home Know their friends/activities Know what apps they are using Require safety protocols Limit screen time

Warning Signs of Exploitation

- Changes in physical appearance new clothes, makeup, jewelry (unexplained)
- Increased health/sexual health-related problems
- Expressions of despair (self-harm, eating disorders, challenging behavior, aggression)
- Increased sexuality
- Isolation
- Defensiveness about location, who they are with, what they are doing
- Extreme fatigue (coupled with other symptoms)
- Fear of being touched
- Experimenting with drugs/alcohol
- Extreme attachment to digital devices
- Missing school or portions of the school day

Taking Back Our Families

Call the church to intentional prayer about sexual integrity/safety. Invite the Spirit to search within - confess and repent of our own sin.

- 1. Consider a weekly/monthly focus, pray in leader meetings, start a special team.
- 2. Review your church's digital safety plan. Is your wi-fi locked down?
- 3. Implement an Intervention & Escalation plan for suspected & self-reported issues.
- 4. Lead/educate from the pulpit. Acknowledge the struggle. Provide support.
- 5. Routinely educate all children's and youth workers.
- 6. Create a team to monitor the digital landscape & share regular updates with workers and parents.
- 7. Add Digital Safety education to your calendar (for children, youth, parents).
- 8. Create safe spaces for youth to share & for parents to support each other.
- 9. Maintain & publish a list of local Resources for youth/families in crisis.
- 10. Help pass laws to protect youth and hold bad actors accountable.
